News from Year 4

The Year 4 project this term is entitled "Who are the heroes of ancient times and why?" and centres on important characters from the Ancient Roman and Greek civilisations.

As the launch day for our project, on Tuesday 17th January, Year 4 took a trip to Norwich Castle Museum. The children were very excited to see some of the things they were learning about in class. The enactments and ancient objects really brought their learning to life.

In the morning the two classes, 4M and 4S, made some Celtic Torcs. These were necklaces like those worn by the Iceni. Torc means 'twist'in the Celtic Language. The children also learned about being in the Roman Army. They were able to see a Roman soldier's uniform and a selection of their weapons. They also had a go at forming a testudo – the turtle formation of shields used so successfully in the Roman Empire. After lunch the children learned about life in an Iceni village and were able to handle 2000 year old Roman pottery and files. They also learned about the Roman occupation of Britain and Boudicca's rebellion.

We will also be learning about Roman architecture and engineering and considering why so much of it still exists 2000 years later. The passage of time is an important concept in this project.

The finale of the project will be an enactment of a Greek and Roman Forum where the children will present what they have made and nominate their hero. The audience will then vote for their favourite from the ancient world.

News from Year 5

We are going to Norwich Castle on Friday 3rd February for a 'Saxons and Vikings' themed day. This will be preceded on the Thursday by a day of Saxons and Vikings work in class.

We have a lady from the council coming in the week before half term to talk to the children about designing playgrounds and making sure they are safe/suitable.

We are attempting to book the Town Hall for our exhibition, we will keep you informed!

So far, 5R and 5T have performed their class prayers in assembly with 5A due to perform theirs on 10th February.

News from Mrs Simons, RE Coordinator and Y6 Class Teacher

Our Easter service will be held on Thursday 30th March at 11am. Parents/carers and other family members are welcome to attend; we look forward to seeing you there.
