Curriculum Information: Year 6

Spring Term 2018

Art skills:

All areas of DT will be covered during the spring term as the children design and create their own gadgets that will be judged by an expert from Nexus at the end of the term.

Scientific & technological skills:

Science is not a part of this project, however they will be using their ICT skills as they design their gadgets as some may even be made on the 3D printer!

Humanities skills:

Aspects of Geography will be covered this term as they locate different countries on the map with particular reference to Europe, Russia and North America.

In History, the children will be looking at turning points in British history.

Maths skills:

The children will be using the assertive mentoring tests to consolidate what they are taught.

They will be practicing test papers and techniques to answer these questions more and more in the run up to the KS2 National Curriculum Tests.

English skills :
