Come in and have a cuppa and a chat. We are available to discuss any concerns you might have or to share some positives about your child's learning or behaviour

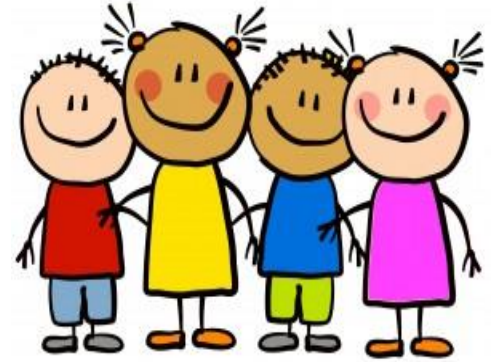
We have an autism specialist who comes to school every week who is available to support parents.
