In Norfolk over 40% of child seats have a fitting issue, but most of these can be fixed immediately. During the summer Norfolk County Council's Road Safety and Fire & Rescue Teams will once again be working together to offer **free child seat checks and advice** at the above locations between 10:00 and 14:00 (apart from 8 August).

If you have any questions or concerns please pop along and see us. Five minutes of your time will ensure that your children are as safe as they can be when travelling in the car. Remember, more Norfolk children are injured or killed in a car than as pedestrians or cyclists. We are here to help (and we are lovely). 😊
