Curriculum Information: Summer 2017/2018

Art skills:

Children will be looking at and researching famous designers and architects in history!

They will also have the opportunity to design masks based on ancient Benin art.

Scientific & technological skills:

The Year 6 children will be identifying and naming parts of the human circulatory system and identifying how plants and animals adapt to suit their environment

Humanities skills:

The children will be examining and comparing Parisian circus' and shows to a local show and will also be delving into the history of Benin!

Maths skills:

The children will be consolidating their knowledge of the four operations in preparation for their SATs tests in May.

They will also be developing their reasoning skills.

English skills :

Year 6 will get the opportunity to understand and consolidate their knowledge of how to use the passive voice accurately and will be able to create atmosphere within their writing by writing a story about an abandoned theatre!

Music skills:

The children will be practicing their performance skills by improving on their vocals and presentational skills for an audience.
