Curriculum Information

Autumn Term 2018/2019

Art skills:

This term the children will be designing and creating a batik pillowcase. These will be based on Anglo-Saxon designs which they will investigate.

Technological skills:

The children will use Computing programs to create a plan of their Anglo-Saxon designs. They will also use a range of design and technology skills to apply these to the batik pillowcases.

Modern Foreign Languages:

We will be learning French! The children will continue to develop their vocabulary of animals and the body, including learning words and phrases.

Humanities skills:

The children will learn about the history of Great Britain in the time of the Vikings and Anglo-Saxons. They will also use their geography skills to locate and name counties of the United Kingdom, their physical characteristics and how these have changed over time.

Maths skills:

The school follows the Collins maths scheme, which covers all national curriculum objectives throughout the year. The children will develop their multiplication and division skills, along

English skills:

Writing this term will initially be based around Vikings and Anglo-Saxons, focusing on narrative verse and creating a story about going back in time through a portal. Finally, the children will create an explanation text regarding the creation of their batik pillowcase.

Our essential question is: What does it mean to be 'old'?

Music skills:

The children will be creating pieces of music using voice and a range of instruments. They will also develop their understanding or written music.
